1317	Hugh de Culverton makes an exchange of land in Prices Risborough with John de Foxle and his wife Constance. The agreement is that Hugh is to hold his land for life, with the remainder (estate after their deaths) to John and Constance and the heirs of John. Constance is possibly Hugh's daughter and heir.		
1324/5	John dies and Constance takes sole responsibility for the Lordship of Culverton.
